Typical reasons for QuickBooks problem H202

- Inaccurate hosting settings: The hosting service may be turned off on a workstation or the server may not be configured properly to host company files.
- Access is blocked by a firewall or security software: Your QuickBooks program may not be able to connect to the company file because of a firewall on the workstation or server.
- Network data (.ND) or transaction log (.TLG) files that are damaged: A multi-user connection may not be possible if the company file contains faulty network data or transaction log files.
- Incorrect IP address or DNS issues: The computer's IP address might be incorrect in the hosts file, or there could be a conflict with the DNS server.
- File path conflicts: There may be problems if the corporate file is placed in a folder with a convoluted path.

Solution 1: Use the QuickBooks Tool and its feature.

- Step 1: Install the QuickBooks tool hub.
- Step 2: Run QuickBooks Database Server Manager on your server using QuickBooks Tool Hub.

Step 3: In the QuickBooks Tool Hub, run the file Doctor.
